DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

From Reading and West Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike eastbound to Exit 326 (old Exit 24) at Valley Forge. Follow signs for Route 202 South/West Chester Exit 328 (old Exit 26A). Continue on Route 202 South to the Great Valley Exit (Route 29 North). At the first traffic light, turn left onto Swedesford Road. Then take the first left turn into the Penn State Great Valley campus.

From West Chester, Delaware, and South Take Route 202 North to the Great Valley Exit (Route 29 North).

Turn right at the end of the ramp and turn right again at the light onto Route 29 North.

Continue to the next traffic light and turn right onto Swedesford Road.

Continue approximately 2/10s of a mile to the Penn State Great Valley campus on the right.

ASSESS THIS!

What, How and Who Cares?

Assessment—nobody likes it, but these days everybody has to do it. Join us for a program that will help you understand why assessment is considered necessary for academic libraries and provide concrete advice and tips on how to conduct assessment as painlessly as possible.

Our day will start with Peter Hernon from the Simmons Graduate School of Library and Information Science. He will set the stage for the rest of the program, discussing the frameworks of assessment and evaluation, stakeholders' expectations, student learning outcomes, and methods of assessment.

For the second morning session, we have put together a panel of librarians from Penn State, Kutztown University, and Millersville University who have recently taken part in intensive assessment activities and can provide practical advice on how to approach assessment.

For the afternoon session, we have Stephen Spohn, senior consultant in planning and assessment for LYRASIS. He will conduct a hands-on workshop on how to develop a library assessment plan. He will provide worksheets that will help participants brainstorm and gather data for their own plan.
