From Philadelphia

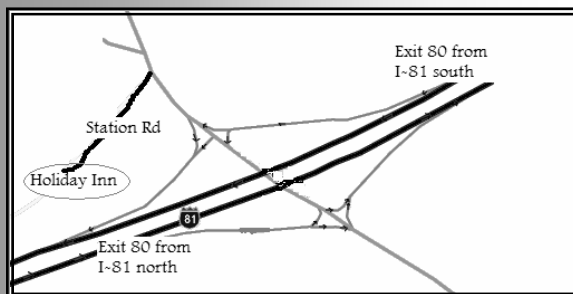
